Full Credit

Students can complete Full Credit classes as long as they have completed the prerequisite course with a 'C+' or higher or have taken the course before. Students can take I or 2 courses from the list below but should remember that Summer Session classes are very concentrated and involve a high commitment in a short period of time.

General Academic Remedial

Students taking Academic Remedial classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students can take a maximum of two Remedial classes and will be able to earn the course credit and a **maximum** mark of 61% (C).

Academic Remedial Classes:

Humanities 8, 9 (Also for students needing EN8/9, SS8/9) Science 8, 9

Brookswood Secondary, July 3 to 27 (4 weeks) 8:30 - 10:40am and/or 11:00am - 1:10pm

Math 8 / 9 Remedial or Preview

Students taking Academic Remedial Math 8 or 9 classes must have already taken the course and received a mark of at least 35% but have not met the learning outcomes or have only done so at a minimal level. Students will receive the course credit with the assigned mark in Math 8 or 9 if they have previously taken the course.

Students who have never taken Math 8 or 9 may "Preview" either course to better prepare for the full course they take next year, **but will not receive credit**.

- ✓ Students are expected to attend all sessions of a class they are registered for. Absence of more than 2 days may result in withdrawal from courses. Students should not be registered in Summer Session if extended absence for any reason is anticipated (e.g. work, vacations, sporting events, family commitments).

Online Registration

Online registration is available for all students and is the quickest way to complete the initial registration. Register online at <u>sd35.coresolutions.ca</u> or visit <u>sd35summersession.ca</u> for more information.

Please Note: Out of District (non-SD35 students) and International students need to have their registration finalized in person at the Langley School Board Office within 7 days of registering online or they will be withdrawn - see below for more information.

Steps to register online at sd35.coresolutions.ca

- 1) Choose "Create a new account" or choose "Use an existing account" if student has registered before.
- 2) Once the account is created or you are logged in, choose "Browse class offerings" to see the available classes and register for the class you are interested in.
- 3) After registration, an e-mail will be sent to you confirming the registration is "Pending". A second confirmation e-mail will be sent to you or you will be contacted by the Summer Session staff, once the registration is "Approved".

In-person Registration

- Any student's registration can be completed in person at the Langley School Board Office.
- Out of District (non-SD35 students) and International students who registered online need to have their registration finalized in person at the Langley School Board Office within 7 days of registering online or they will be withdrawn.

Please note that registration cannot be done over the phone - it must be done online or in person.

Information required when registering:

- Student's Personal Education Number (PEN), a nine digit number located on report cards or available through the student's home school.
- Student's legal and English name if different, phone number(s), address, and parent guardian(s) name(s) and e-mail address.
- If student was not registered in the Langley School District for the 2017/18 school year, proof of parent / guardian(s) Citizenship and BC residency plus the student's birth certificate must be provided.

International Students

- International students already registered in the Langley School District should contact the International Student Program at the Langley School Board Office before registering in Summer Session classes for full information regarding payment options and to confirm homestay arrangements.
- Elementary students can register for their course online or in-person as outlined above. International students are subject to course fees as outlined on the front of this brochure.
- Payment of course fees must be made within 7 days of registration. Registration fees for International elementary students must be paid in person at the Langley School Board office by debit, credit card, cash or cheque. International students withdrawing from courses are subject to a 10% processing fee. Refunds for Secondary classes will not be given after July 3, 2018.
- International students not currently enrolled in the Langley School District should contact the ISP Department if they have questions about eligibility to enroll in Summer Session 2018.
